5. Fire-Fighting Measures

Suitable extinguishing media:

In case of fire be aware of formation of sulfur dioxide and further toxic gases.
Do not allow run-off from firefighting to enter drains or water courses.

Advice for firefighters:

Special protective equipment: In the event of fire, wear self-contained breathing apparatus.
Fire residues and contaminated fire extinguishing water must be disposed of in accordance with local regulations.

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Collect contaminated fire extinguishing water separately. This must not be discharged into drains.

6. Accidental Release Measures

Personal precautions:

PPE should wear protective gloves and there is no requirement for other protective equipment.

After the product leakage is detected, inform the pre-designated operators, quickly set up the prepared collection and storage facilities, collect the leaked product as soon as possible, and then remove the small amount of residual product.

Environmental precautions:

Prevent entry into drains, waters or soil.

Prevent further leakage or spillage if safe to do so

Methods for cleaning up or taking up:

Soak up with inert absorbent material (e.g. sand, silica gel, acid binder, universal binder, sawdust).

Fill into labelled, sealable containers.

Preventive Measures Against Secondary Hazards:

If the leaked product enters the stormwater drainage network, immediately shut down the facility's stormwater discharge outlet, physically remove the product from the stormwater pipeline using non-sparking tools or divert the contaminated stormwater to the facility's emergency containment basin for phase separation.

Ensure containers are tightly sealed to prevent air ingress;
